#### **Atchafalaya Bayou Tour**

Everyday except December 24 & 25

Meeting Point : *Atchafalaya National Heritage Welcome Center*, Exit 121 (Butte La Rose) on Highway 1-10 EAST (from Lafayette)

Time : 10AM      Duration : 2 to 2½ Hours

#### **Atchafalaya Airboat Bayou Tour**

This airboat tour will take you through the largest protected wetlands in the USA just outside in Lafayette. #### **Bike Rental along the St. Tammany Trace**

Everyday except certain holidays

Place : 416 E. Gibson Street, Covington, LA 70433 (67km / 50 minutes from New Orleans)

Times : 8AM – 5PM Duration: 1 hour up to all day rental

##### *Description*

The St. Tammany Trace was developed from land purchased from the Illinois Central Railroad thanks to local, state and national government cooperation. It is a rider's dream path of more than the 45km of paved road-way exclusively used for cyclists. One you leave Covington, you can pass (depending on how long you want to cycle) through the towns of Abita Springs, Mandeville and Lacombe and even reach as far as Slidell. Choose a short distance or the entire 45+km depending on your experience and feel completely invigorated afterwards!

#### **Insta-Gator (Alligator) Ranch Tour**

Everyday except certain holidays

Place : 74645 Allen Road, Covington, LA 70435 (77km / 1 hour from New Orleans)

Times : 11AM-2PM Duration: approximately 1½ hours

##### *Description*

Here you have a tour out of the ordinary! This tour allows the visitor to discover the complete history of the governmental controlled alligator industry that saved this once near endangered species. On this tour you will see alligators of all sizes and walk away with a better appreciation of this marvelous creature.

### DES ALLEMANDS :

#### **Swamp Tour of South Louisiana**

Everyday except certain holidays

Meeting Point : 4298 US-90, Des Allemands, LA 70030

Times : 10:30AM, 1:30PM, 3:30PM / Duration : 1-1½ hours

##### *Description*

This swamp tour is more intimate than other swamp tours as it limits (up to 11) in will take in its boat. Your captain is a native to the region and therefore knows the various paths through the winding bayous in this are of South Louisiana. ### ST. MARTINVILLE :
