Options in Atlanta:

Georgia Aquarium:

You'll come closer than ever before to their animal inhabitants with visits to the topside decks of Ocean Voyager and Tropical Diver, plus you'll get to visit the Corral Center, commissary and Ocean Voyager filtration room, where they house the equipment that filters our 6.3 million gallon habitat.
